HIVE LEVY INCREASE

Resolution 1.

That the Levy rate for a beekeeper's first Apiary be \$55.00, with each subsequent Apiary to be levied at the rate of \$24.20 for the 1999 year.

Resolution 2.

That the Levy rate for a beekeeper's first Apiary be \$57.50, with each subsequent Apiary to be levied at the rate of \$25.30 for the 1999 year.

Resolution 3.

That the Levy rate for a beekeeper's first Apiary be \$60.00, with each subsequent Apiary to be levied at the rate of \$26.40 for the 1999 year.

Resolution 4.

That the Levy rate for a beekeeper's first Apiary be \$62.50, with each subsequent Apiary to be levied at the rate of \$27.50 for the 1999 year.
