Change to Metric Weights

We have no answer to the problem of a change to Metric Weights for honey packed after August in Imperial weights as yet.

Beeswax Prices

Our grapevine information is that the price of beeswax paid by Ecroyd is good :- \$4.40 per kg for good *Ax. Overseas Buyers are paying \$4.10 per kg and this for refined filtered beeswax with the Export Incentive which is allowed for refined beeswax only, gives you a better return than Ecroyd as the Export Incentive is worth approximately \$1.00 per kg.

EDITORIAL

"Te regret a late issue of this Bulletin but there has not been a great deal of news with the exception that there appears to be a general shortage of honey.

There is no doubt in my mind that our Association must spend time and thought on marketing as if we as packers are going to improve our position we must combine our activities to obtain access to overseas markets.

The H.M.A. will stall any individual action to allow access to exports as exports will mean increased prices to producers putting the price of honey up on the retail market.

While the H.N.A. control exports they control the price the consumer pays and the price the producer receives.

We must look at packaging as a group as we have already proved with our 2kg pot we can improve our position.

I have already investigated a complete plastic 500 gram Pottle that could work out cheaper than the present one in use and have a 36 x 500 gram cardboard container printed that could be used as a general honey container purchased as a gang run at a cheaper price by honey packers.

Fore about these items at our next meetings to be held at Ngongotaha on 25th of June and at the time of the National Beekeepers Conference in the South Island.

I would appeal again to you to give me your ideas for publication in our bulletin.
