We wish to advise that our "Commercial Type" Roofs, Bottoms and Storeys have proved very popular since their introduction last season. Beekeepers are finding them a very attractive proposition especially when taking their high quality and low price into account.

If you usually make your own woodware we ask but one thing of you—accurately check your costs against our prices. There have been many cases this last season of beekeepers making this check and immediately becoming "another satisfied customer". Repeat orders prove this.

The following are our terms and prices:-

In offering these goods we have set the following conditions which must be strictly adhered to:

Minimum quantity per item-50.

Can be ordered either direct from us or through Stockists, but all deliveries are made direct.

Prices f.o.r. Christchurch.

Cash with order unless arrangements have been made to operate a monthly account.

Where a monthly account is operated a surcharge of 5% will be added to invoice value, but this is deductable provided payment in full is made by the end of the month following delivery.

STOREYS: These are made of the same high quality selected timber as in the past. The only difference is that the corners are "half checked" and not lock cornered as are our standard storeys.

ROOFS: Have heavier timber on the top— $\frac{7}{3}$ " or $\frac{3}{4}$ " at our discretion against the present $\frac{5}{3}$ ". The side rails have butted corners instead of lock corners, which we consider will have little if any adverse effect on the strength as the nailing of the top piece to the side rails makes it a very rigid job. The heavier timber of the top pieces makes a much more solid roof which will be less inclined to blow off.

Price: 5/0 each plus iron (optional) @ 4/9 per sheet—total 9/9 each.

BOTTOMS: Consist of a decking $16 \times 21\frac{1}{2}$ " made of $\frac{7}{8}$ " or $\frac{3}{4}$ " timber at our discretion, with a $\frac{7}{8}$ " x $\frac{3}{4}$ " rim to take the storey.

Price: 4/0 each plus 2/6 a pair for 16 inch 4×2 Beech Rails (optional) on to which the platform is fastened. (N.B. The platform is not in itself a complete bottom. The 4×2 rails or a substitute are needed to bind the platform together.)

The above lines unless otherwise specified are of standard hive dimensions. We will manufacture to your own dimensions if required at little or no extra cost, as we realise that some may prefer deeper side rails on roofs, longer bottom boards, etc.

FRAMES: Our standard full depth Hoffman Frames can be supplied at £27/2/6 per 1000 and for this quantity or more we will pay all freight to your nearest railway station in the South Island or your nearest port in the North Island.

Simplicity frames although not carried in stock can be manufactured against minimum orders of 1000 and supplied at £25/12/0 per 1000 freight paid as above.

Delivery of Commercial Type lines can be within about 2 weeks of the placing of an order. Hoffman frames can normally be supplied ex stock.
