In order that the packages containing the bees may be examined at Auckland by an officer of this Department, and to ensure that the conditions of importation have been satisfactorily complied with, the consignees have been instructed to arrange for the package to be clearly endorsed "To be held at Auckland for examination by Department of Agriculture."

I shall be glad, therefore, if you will arrange for this Department to be advised directly the bees come to hand, in order that the necessary examination may be made prior to frowarding them to their destination.
