Introduction of Bees

In accordance with the regulations relating to the introduction into New Zealand of bees or appliances - Gazette Notice No. 2387 - a permit has been issued for the importation of bees as follows:-

H. Brown, Cape May, Court House, New Jersey.	Mrs. S. I. Hopkins, Post Office, Rotorua.	Nucleus Colony Crossbred Bees

In order that the packages containing the bees may be examined at Auckland by an officer of this Department, and to ensure that the conditions of importation have been satisfactorily complied with, the consignees have been instructed to arrange for the package to be clearly endorsed "To be held at Auckland for examination by Department of Agriculture."

I shall be glad, therefore, if you will arrange for this Department to be advised directly the bees come to hand, in order that the necessary examination may be made prior to forwarding them to their destination.
